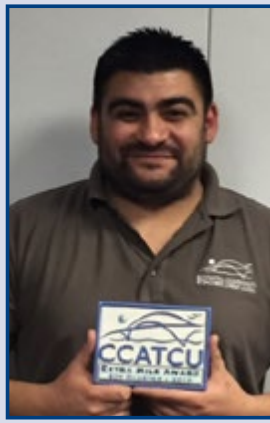

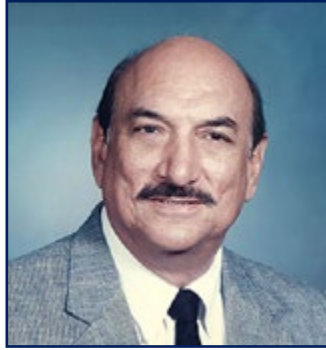
Board of Directors
